NEWS FLASH!!!

Please dress your child for outdoor play as we use the playground throughout the winter, depending on the temperatures. Children need to run and play outside for good health and release some of their energy. We will always provide them with an alternative play area when the weather is poor or too cold. NEWSFLASH

Many children have little opportunity to play creatively. Instead they experience only "programmed" play such as computer games, television, videos, scheduled classes and sports. Some programmed play is important because it helps children build academic

skills, but I am more inclined to support the thought that children need to use their imaginations, dream their thoughts and "unwind" from the hectic schedules that most families experience these days. This applies to preschool curriculum as well as home. We try to balance our program to include

creativity along with the academics. When your child comes home with "art" that you wonder what it is, just remember, it is his own creation and it means something to him in that he was the artist. Often he can tell you more about the "art" than you can see. Take time to ask and LISTEN!!

Don't forget to register your child for next year. Registration begins on Feb. 1.

The registration fee is \$125.00 for the first child and \$75.00 for each additional child. Your "spot" is not assured until you pay the fee.
